- IWB, October 2009 (new IC)

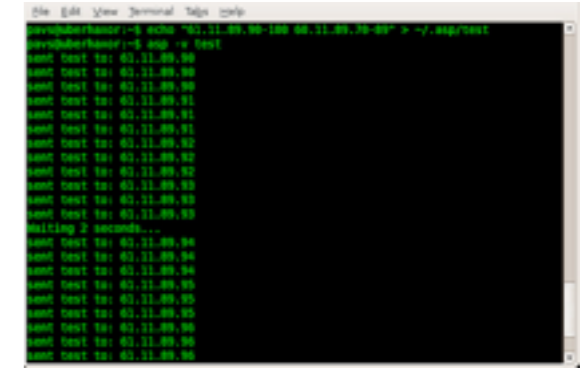


# New participants...

# New IP addresses...



- Since September 2009 SwissIX has a new network-range for peering: 91.206.52.0/23
- All participants followed to renumber
- We've introduced two new RouteServer, based on OpenBSD (OS) and OpenBGPD (Routing Daemon)
- We share +7500 prefixes on the RouteServer

# New traffic... 1/3

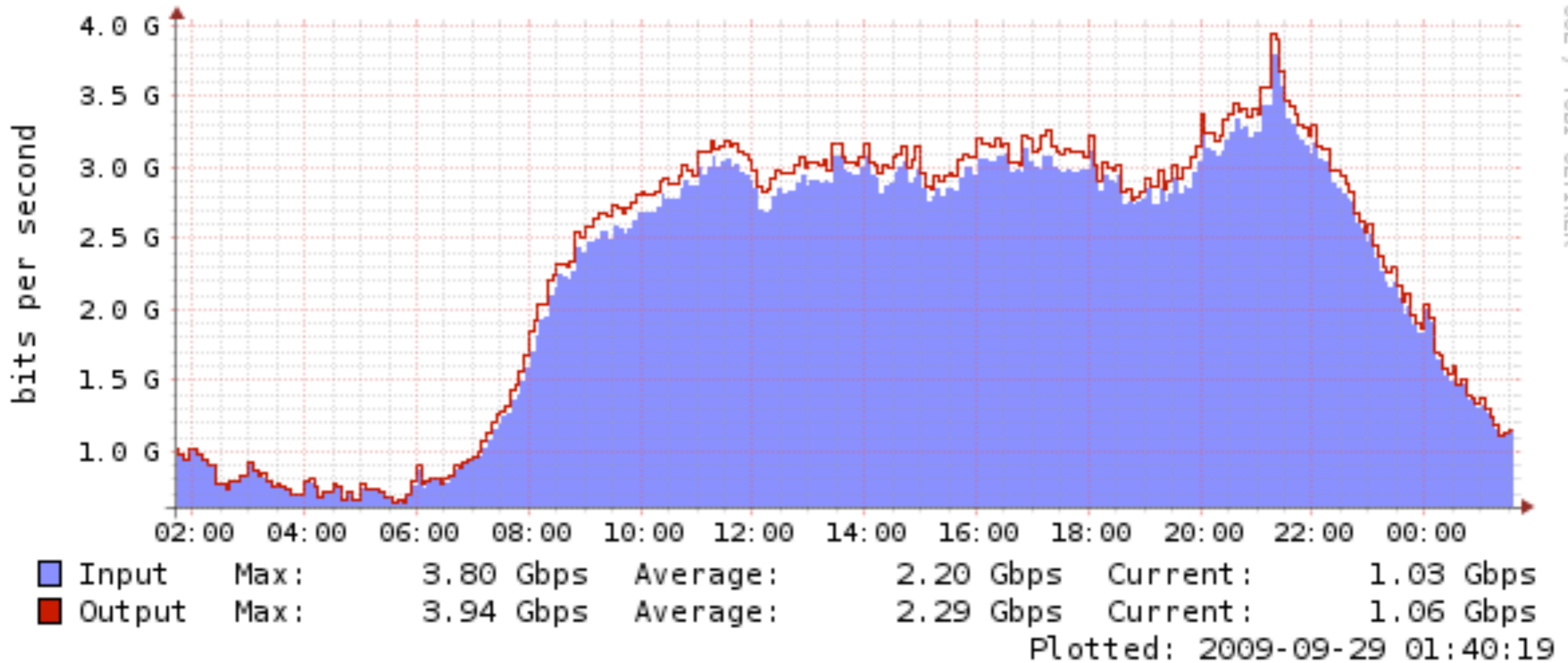


- Since SwiNOG18 (April '09) we had „summertime“ and we've lost some traffic due to routing changes on some participant networks
- Currently we're seeing <5 Gbps (peak) but we expect some growth in the next 1-3 months due to new participants connected

# New traffic... 2/3



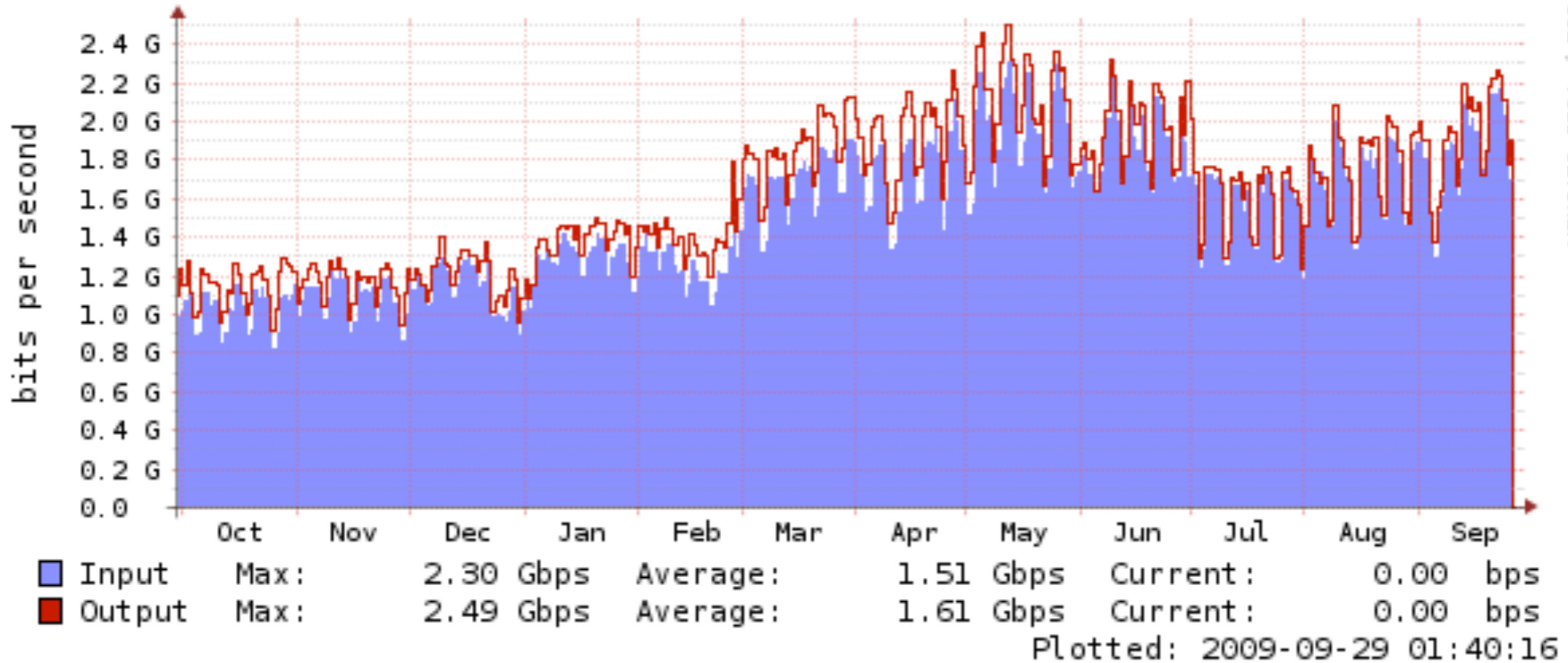
Daily graph of total aggregated traffic
