abuse-c periodic check

- attribute introduced with RIPE-705: validation every year
- the normal validation is non-intrusive
- if it fails, RIPE-NCC sends an e-mail with a link
- if nothing comes back, RIPE-NCC starts asking the LIR, etc.
- pilot on some LIR and end users: 18% invalid

Legal addresses in the RIPE DB

- Europol proposal (2018-05): add legal addresses of Internet number resource holders into the RIPE DB
- besides the “role:” object, there should be some reference for law-related business
- strong objections were raised at RIPE-77:
 - Who is responsible to enter and keep accurate data?
 - Legal implications
 - ...
- discussion within the *NCC services* working group

Automatic cleanup of RIPE-NONAUTH objects with RPKI data

- creation of new RIPE-NONAUTH objects is not allowed
- proposal (2018-06): if a RIPE-NONAUTH “route(6):” object also has an encompassing RPKI registration, it is automatically deleted from the RIPE DB, regardless of the maintainer
- no consensus at RIPE-77: the authors will work on a new draft
- discussion within the ***Routing*** working group
- encourage customers with RIPE-NONAUTH to set up a clean registration
