






# **Current Network Topology**

## Route Server Blackholing

#### Request to all participants:

Make sure you accept routes as small as /32(IPv4) or /128(IPv6) from the route servers (in general or if tagged with community 65535:666). This is an important step to make this service work. Please do your part in helping SwissIX fight DDoS attacks.

#### **Recommendation:**

Drop traffic to IPv4 91.206.53.254 and IPv6 2001:7f8:24::1fe (Blackhole next-hop) already on your router if possible. This helps keeping your links to SwissIX free. If not dropped at your router, this traffic will be blocked on ingress on our switches.

#### In case of an attack on your network:

- Blackhole filtering of more specific IP prefixes can be requested by tagging them with the following BGP commu-nities: 42476:666:0, 65535:666 (BLACKHOLE well-known community)
- By default, routes are propagated to all the clients unless they have been explicitly configured to not receive them.
- IPv4 routes are propagated to clients after their NEXT\_HOP attribute has been rewritten to 91.206.53.254.
- IPv6 routes are propagated to clients after their NEXT\_HOP attribute has been rewritten to 2001:7f8:24::1fe.
- Before being announced to clients, all the routes are tagged with the BLACKHOLE well-known community. The NO\_EXPORT well-known community is also added.
- Blackhole filtering requests bypass any RPKI validation check and min/max length check.
