Outsourcing Goals

- The partner must have experience with an IXP and should actively and verifiably manage this market
- 24x7 operation and support with guaranteed response times must be possible
- SwissIX remains the owner of the platform and has full control over all components and configurations, at least in the event of an emergency
- Vendor lock-in should be avoided
- An exit strategy for the event of economic difficulties for the partners involved must be in place before the start of the replacement




Outsourcing Goals (cont'd)

- SwissIX must be able to plan with certainty for at least five years
- The location and ownership of any data should remain entirely with SwissIX
- Further services, comparable to our neighboring IXP, should be easy to implement
- The replacement must be possible within a reasonable time frame with the available human resources of SwissIX



New SwissIX Topology






Key facts about new platform

- New fibres
- Two cores
- 400 Gbps core bandwidth (upgradable)
- Each edge has redundant connection to core sites
- Nokia HW
- (Enhanced) EVPN instead of VPLS
- BIRD routeservers
- New self-service portal
 - Enhanced black-holing
 - Advanced statistisc

Overall findings
